The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Los Angeles District, will be holding a public forum to discuss topics of interest relating to the Corps' activities along the Los Angeles River and specifically, within the area referred to as "Glendale Narrows."

Meeting Topic: Flood risk and strategies that the Corps is implementing to manage the risk of flooding for communities adjacent to the Los Angeles River from Zoo Drive to Riverside Drive/Figueroa Street.

The Corps Asset Management Division, Operations and Maintenance Branch, invites you to an evening forum on the flood risk potential of the Glendale Narrows section of the Los Angeles River. The forum will include a presentation on what the existing flood risk is and how the Corps is working to reduce flood risk. Topics to be covered include the use of temporary barriers, channel repair, and vegetation management. Questions and comments will be taken at the end of the meeting.



The Corps Asset Management Division, Operation and Maintenance Branch, area of responsibility covers all the Corps owned flood control structures within the Los Angeles District boundaries. Part of the Operation and Maintenance Branch responsibility is the maintenance and operation of Corps owned flood control structures within the Los Angeles County Drainage Area, which includes 5 dams, one debris basin, and 45 miles of flood control channel.
